## Captain Eddie Only Film Not In Light Vein

Except in one case, the movies this week will be turned toward the light and comical type. The one picture which isn't should prove to be of great significance to everyone.

"Captain Eddie," the new feature based on the exciting career and exploits of Eddie Rickenbacker, is currently showing at the Quilna theatre. Fred MacMurray depicts Rickenbacker in the picture, which takes the American hero from his childhood days in Columbus, thru his World War I adventure, and on to his harrowing experiences afloat, with the crew of his plane on a raft in the Pacific.
