Hawaii Mars Cost 2 Million

BALTIMORE, Aug. 13—(AP)—The Hawaii Mars, giant flying boat which crashed into Chesapeake Bay a week ago while on a test run, cost more than \$2,000,000 to build, Navy department figures showed today.

A Navy spokesman at Washington disclosed in an interview with The Baltimore News-Post that the contract given the Glenn Martin Aircraft Co. had called for construction of 20 flying boats of the type for \$40,000,000.

Hoover Sees Communism On Gain In Europe

LONG BEACH, Calif., Aug. 13—(AP)—Former President Herbert Hoover declared today "Communism or creeping Socialism are sweeping over Europe; they are beginning in Asia." He said the time had come for America to proclaim its faith in its system of life.

In an address for delivery to the annual picnic of the Iowa Association of Southern California on his first birthday, the former chief executive said with reference to political changes abroad:

"The causes lie deep in the holocaust of misery from the war, from power politics, from the impulses for any change from the bitter years which have passed and from the years of propaganda of a new Utopia.

"A score of Fascist nations have shifted to Communism, and half a dozen nations once liberty-loving are shifting to Socialism. The most recent chapter is the Socialist victory in Britain.

"Whatever the particular name of these European systems may be, whether it be Communism, Socialism or the decoy term, 'planned economy,' they are all collectivist. They all have a common base in bureaucratic power over the liberties and economic life of the people.

"In the extreme form they leave little of free speech, free press, free assembly or independent justice."
