Corn Makes Good Progress

With temperatures averaging 2 to 4 degrees above normal during the past week, hot weather crops grew rapidly, the Milwaukee federal weather bureau reported today in its weekly crop summary.

Warm Weather Aids State Crops

The related corn crop made encouraging progress, especially during the latter part of the week. The crop in southern and central Wisconsin was silking and caring on tall stalks. The bureau said that "with favorable weather during the next few weeks a fairly good crop is in prospect."
