DELPHOS, Sept. 5.—A house to house solicitation was started here today in an effort to obtain 450 additional workers for the St. Mary's Packing Co., which confronts a serious problem with a help shortage in packing the tomato crop in this vicinity.

Robert Ash, manager, said the bean crop also is ready and a portion of the help will be required to process pork and beans for government requirements. Unless help is imported thru government action a large portion of the crop this year will be left to perish at receiving stations. The company has large tomato acreage contracted but will face no serious help problem in pumpkin processing, Ash said. Solicitors were to complete their survey Wednesday morning.
