## Tito Backs Group Opposed To King

BELGRADE, Sept. 11—(AP)—Marshall Tito today accepted an offer of the People's Front executive committee to sponsor at forthcoming elections a united front ticket pledged to unseat King Peter and establish a Yugoslavian democracy.

The Front's complete program, to be made public soon, will include planks calling for establishment of a republican democracy under a "solid peoples' rule," and warning against the return of Peter until a constitutional convention decides the form for a future government.

**West Point Resumes Four-Year Course**  
WEST POINT, N. Y., Sept. 11—(AP)—Maj. Gen. Maxwell D. Taylor, superintendent of the United States Military Academy, said today the academic course at West Point would go back to a four-year basis with a broadening of aviation instruction for all cadets.

Taylor said the present first, or senior class, would graduate next June, culminating three years of instruction. However, the present third class, he said, would be diverted into two parts, one part graduating after three years and the other remaining for the complete four-year course.
