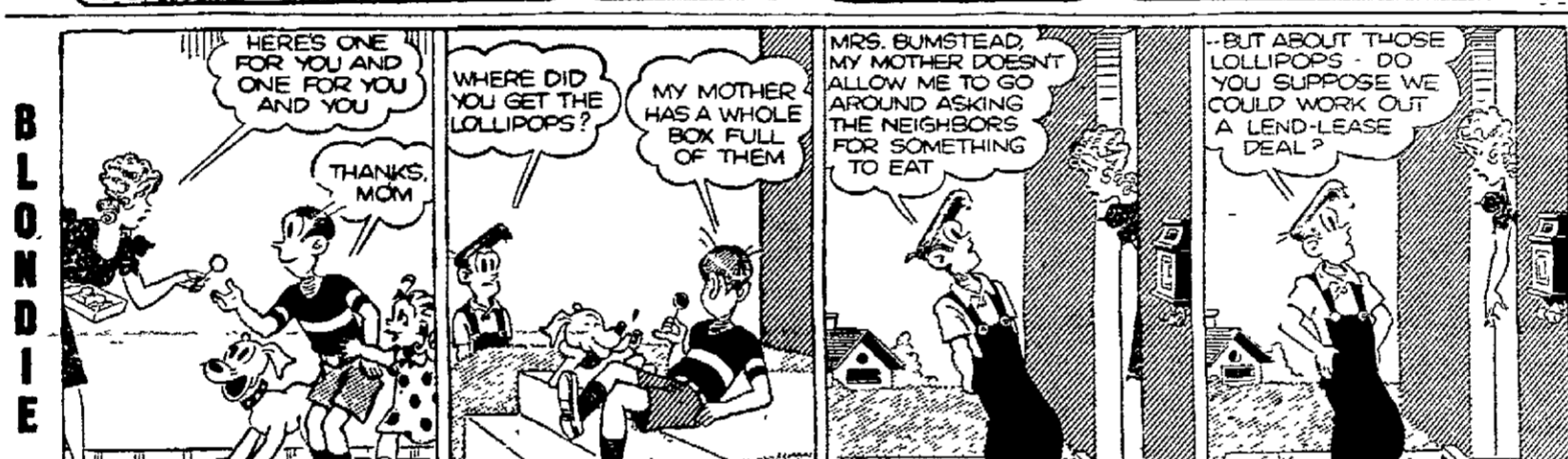
ASHLEY BANK JOINS FR

Drop Forecast In Ohio Lambs
COLUMBUS, Sept. 12 (AP)—Ohio's 1945 lamb crop was estimated at 1,019,000 head today by the U. S. Department of Agriculture, as compared with 1,057,000 last year and a 10-year average of 1,294,000.

The state's wool production was forecast as 12,231,000 pounds. The yield last year was 13,088,000 pounds and the 10-year average is 17,160,000 pounds.

The department said that the estimated number of cattle on feed the Aug. 1 was 95 per cent of the total on the same date last year.
