**Sewer Bond Issue Is Gaining Headway**

ST. MARYS, Sept. 13 — City council passed a motion Tuesday to proceed with the plan to submit a \$150,000 bond issue for improvement of sanitary and storm sewers and construction of a sanitary sewerage disposal plant. The county auditor notified council that the \$150,000 bond issue would require a tax levy of 1.295 mills over a period of 25 years to retire the bonds and pay the interest. This would be based on the present tax valuation of the city.

A committee from the American Legion met with the council, asking that body to consider the construction of a hospital here as a post-war project.

## Marine Point Score Reduced

WASHINGTON, Sept. 13—(AP)—The Marine Corps today reduced its critical point score for release of male personnel from 85 to 70 points, and authorized release of all Marines 35 years of age and older.

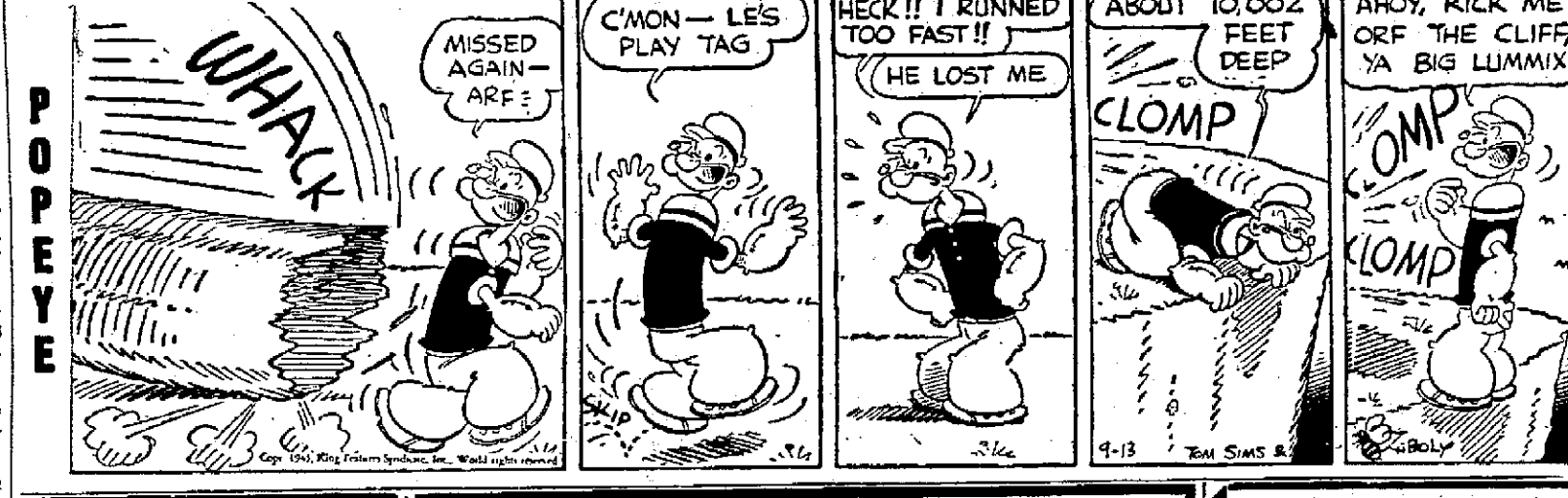
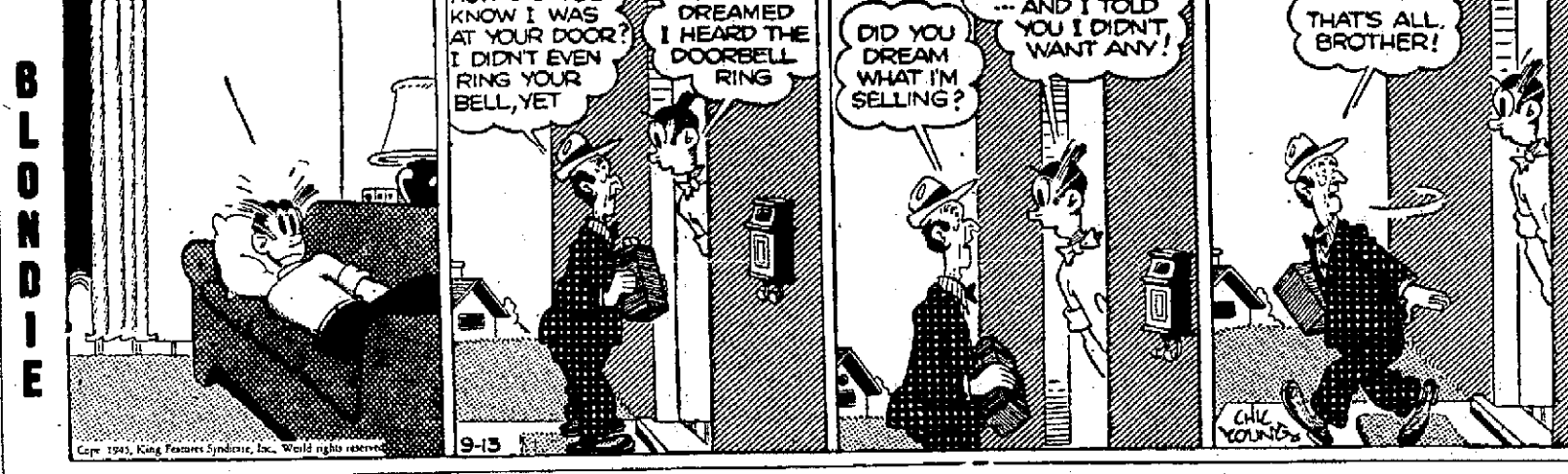
The changes, announced by Gen. A. Vandegrift, Marine Corps commandant, are effective immediately.

They are the first reduction in the Marines' critical score, originally announced Aug. 15.

In connection with the release of personnel over 35, it was pointed out that the Marine Corps point system, unlike that for the rest of the Navy, allows no credit for age.
