

Film Based On Pulitzer Novel Opens At Quilna

Triumphantly reaching the screen as it did the heart of the nation and the world, John Hersey's great and human Pulitzer prize-winning novel, "A Bell for Adano," opens Friday at the Quilna theatre starring Gene Tierney, John Hodiak and William Bendix with a brilliant supporting cast.

The picture tells of Major Joppolo, played by John Hodiak, who came to a small, bomb-blasted village in Sicily and saw a people without laughter—a woman without hope, and how he conquered their fears with his courage and her heart with his arms. PORTLAND, Ore., Sept. 14—(INS)—Europe faces "the worst winter since the 30 years' war," Dr. Frank Munk, an official of the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration, said today.
