Monument on Atomic Bomb Site Proposed

WASHINGTON, Sept. 15—(AP)—Secretary of Interior Ickes took steps today to create a new national monument at the site of the first atomic explosion.

The first atomic bomb was exploded July 16 on public grazing lands withdrawn in 1942 for use by the War department as a bombing range.

Ickes directed Fred W. Johnson, commissioner of the general land office, to reserve the lands surrounding the place of the atomic bomb experiment for a new national monument.

OTTAWA AWAITS CROSSING RULING

Improved Safety Facilities Asked For Village

(Lima News Bureau)—OTTAWA, Sept. 15—Municipal officials of Ottawa still were waiting Thursday for a decision of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio regarding their application for improved safety facilities at three crossings of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad in Ottawa.

The commission took the matter under advisement last week following a hearing in Columbus. During the hearing, extensive arguments were advanced by both the municipal and railroad representatives.

E. B. Unverferth, Ottawa solicitor, was in charge of the presentation of evidence for the community. He reiterated the request of the Ottawa Council that a watchman be employed at the Main-st. crossing 24 hours daily and that flasher warning signals be installed at the Second and Third-st. crossings.

The railroad has asked the commission to authorize it to install flasher signals at all three crossings and eliminate the present 16-hour watchman protection.
