# "Greenwich Village" Opens Run On Screen At Lyric

Reaching back into colorful post World War I's "roaring '20's" for its plot and musical setting, "Greenwich Village," the technicolor excursion into another exciting period of America's past, makes its opening appearance at the Lyric theatre, Monday.

In the film Don Ameche essays another intriguing role as a young composer who came out of Kansas to win a reputation in the Arabian Nights atmosphere of Greenwich Village. The picture also provides Carmen Miranda with her first role since "The Gang's All Here," and offers her the opportunity to display her newly discovered talents as a comedienne.

Texas Guinan the woman who set New York on fire in the "roaring '20's" is portrayed by Betty Hutton in the Ohio theatre's current picture "Incendiary Blonde." Telling the story of the famous Guinan's life from the time she rode a bucking bronco in a rodeo to win \$50 to the time that she became owner and manager of one of the most famous night spots in New York.

Bette Davis has been cast in the part of a school teacher who sets up a system of schooling to train Welsh coal miners.
