End Of V-Mail

Nov. 1 Forecast

WASHINGTON, Sept. 15—(UP)—Microfilming of V-mail will end about Nov. 1, authoritative sources said today.

War, Navy and postal authorities are expected to make a joint statement soon on termination of V-mail which was begun in June, 1942, to hasten mail delivery to servicemen overseas and to conserve shipping space. Approximately 2,000,000, 000 V-mail letters have been microfilmed since the war began.
