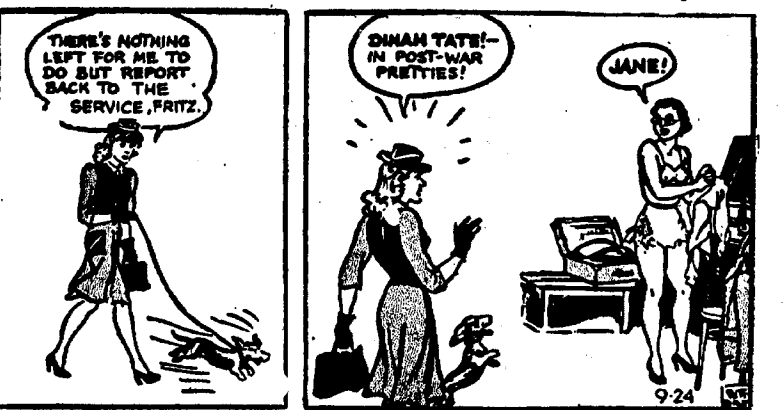

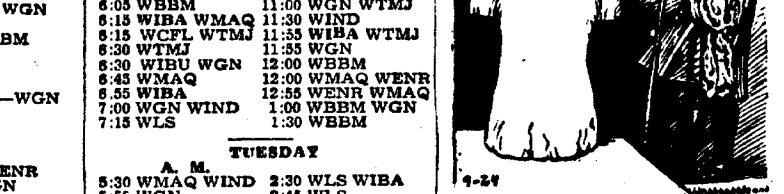
Egyptian King Had Secret Tomb

The other day I asked a young college graduate this question: "Did you ever hear of Tutankhamen?" "No," she replied. "Did you ever hear of King Tut?" I inquired. "Oh, yes!" she said, with a smile.

King Tut and Tutankhamen are, of course, names for the same person, an ancient king of Egypt. People adopted the short form of "King Tut" after finding it hard to remember, or pronounce, the full name.

From all that has been said about this king, we might suppose he was one of the great rulers of Egypt. The fact is that he held the throne for only a short time and had little real power. His fame has grown from the treasures he left behind him.

Twenty-five years ago, no one knew where King Tut had been buried. A few objects bearing his name had been found in the Valley of the Kings, but there was no record to show where his body had been laid to rest.

The Valley of the Kings is a famous part of Egypt. It is known more correctly by the longer name of "Valley of the Tombs of the Kings." It is about 350 miles south of Cairo, not far from the remains of the ancient city of Thebes.

At the time the pyramids were being built, the Valley of the Kings was a barren place. A monarch had no idea of using it as a burial ground.

Yet there was need of some change. Big as they were, the pyramids had been entered and robbed. Mummies had been taken out, and royal treasures had been stolen.

So it came about that a king named Thothmes I, decided to have the body, or mummy, placed in the barren valley near Thebes. By good fortune, we have a statement left about the first tomb in that valley. It was written by a high official named Ineni, and
