Travelers Found Tombs in Valley

Travelers Found Tombs in Valley of the Kings
The Egyptian who managed the cutting of the first tomb in the Valley of the Kings put words on the with the meaning:

"It was a job such as the ancestors had not done. I shall be praised for my wisdom. Others will imitate what I have done." That man was right. Other kings had their tombs cut in the cliffs and hillsides. The valley was

used by at least 30 monarchs.

The secret was kept for a while, but robbers at length learned where they might find royal treas-ure. One tomb after another was ure. One tomb after another was entered as the years went by.

The kings left money for guards who were to watch the tombs, but the money ran out in time. Very likely some of the guards were greedy for gold, and joined the tomb robbers in getting plunder!

Centuries passed and the centuries passed and the centuries passed.

Centuries passed, and the centuries added up to thousands of years. Then along came foreign travelers. In 1815 Belzoni, an Italian, started digging into the cliffs

to see what the tombs contained.
He found a few treasures, but all the tombs he visited had been robbed long before.
Much the same story may be told about Theodore Davis, an American who spent 12 years in the Valley of the King. the Valley of the Kings — from 1902 to 1914. Davis located several tombs which had not been seen in modern times. Every tomb he en-tered had been robbed of most of its contents, although he did ob-

tain a few treasures.

After Davis had given up hope of finding anything else of im-portance in the valley, two Eng-lishmen went to work there. They were Lord Carnarvon and Howard Carter. Most of the work was di-

rected by Carver, since Carnar-von was in ill health.

Six years passed without a discovery of any great importance.

Then, on a November day in 1922,
Carter and his workmen found a Carter and his workmen found a sunken stairway which had been hidden by a mass of debris. This stairway led to a door. A cable-gram called Lord Carnarvon from England to Egypt. Together with Carter he opened the door and saw the greatest mass of treasure over found in a tomb. It was the ever found in a tomb.
