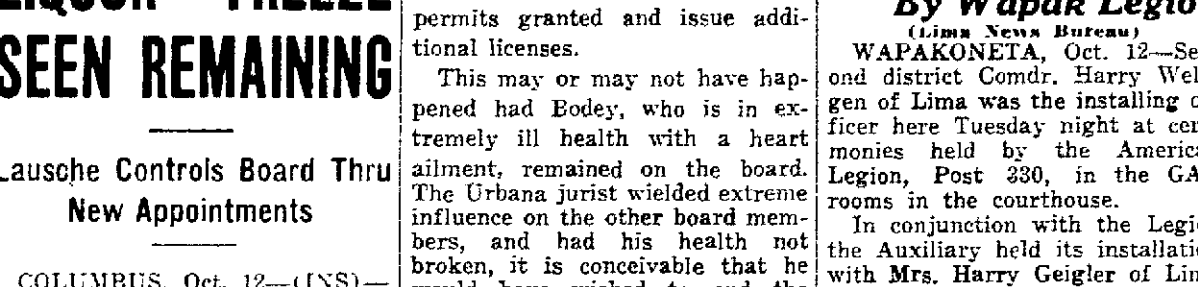

NEW YORK, Oct. 12—(INS)—New York hotel men have the "Invasion" jitters.

Somewhere in the Atlantic, between the locks of the Panama Canal and in the Pacific, 35 ships and some 30,000 men of the fleet which licked Japan now are heading for New York for Navy Day.

Most of them (the men, not the ships) will be wanting hotel rooms. And so will their families, friends and sweethearts.

Everybody else was cordially invited today to stay away.

In case you didn't know, there isn't any hotel space, hasn't been for a long time, and if you added up the number of rooms available to new, non-naval transients after Oct. 15 it would total a rimless zero.

The Hotel Association of New York was busy distributing to its 190 member hotels notices to be posted in guest rooms which politely warn that few new reservations will be honored between Oct. 15 and Nov. 6, when the Navy takes over the town.

Exciting apartment-hotels, New York has a total of 404 hotels, with an aggregate of 122,000 rooms.
