

Lyric Film Has Adventure— Shows History Being Made

Most exciting and dramatic scene play of recent months is "Storm Over Lisbon" which opened Monday at the Lyric theatre.

International intrigue filmed against the background of a Portuguese city where the nationals of many countries meet, the picture which captures the stirring adventure of history in the making, is an excellent starring vehicle for Vera Hruba Ralston, who has her second dramatic role as Maritza, an internationally famous dancer on a secret governmental mission.

It's not often that folks get the chance to see two pictures—top notch ones at that—on the same billing but at the Quilna theatre this week, this really happens. Films are "Pennies From Heaven" with Bing Crosby, and "Mr. Deeds Goes to Town" with Gary Cooper and Jean Arthur.

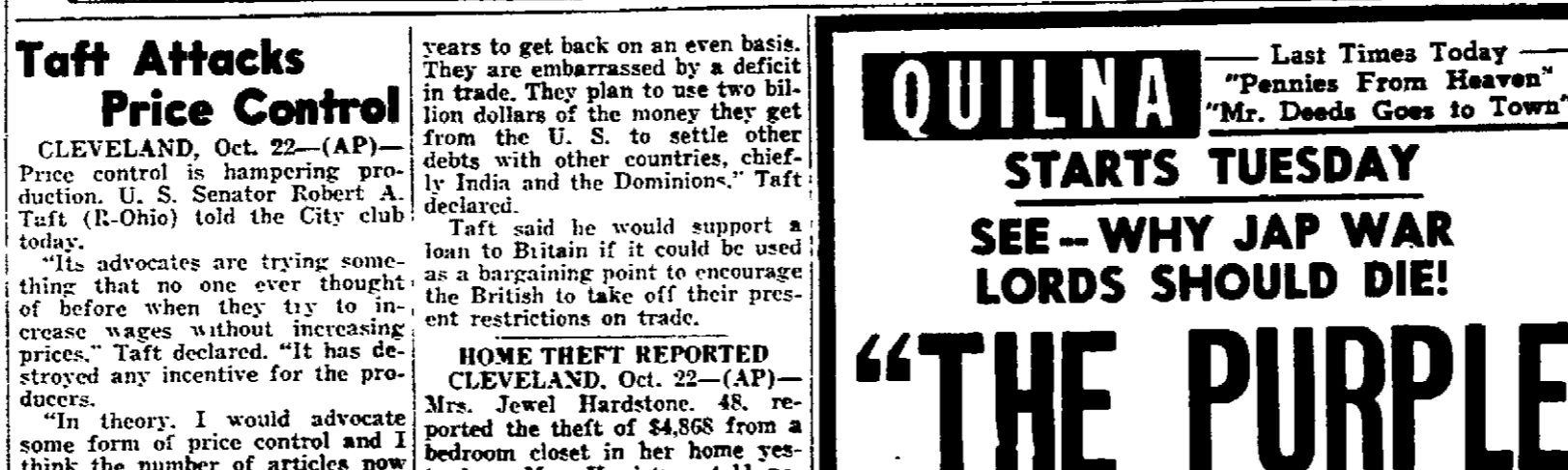
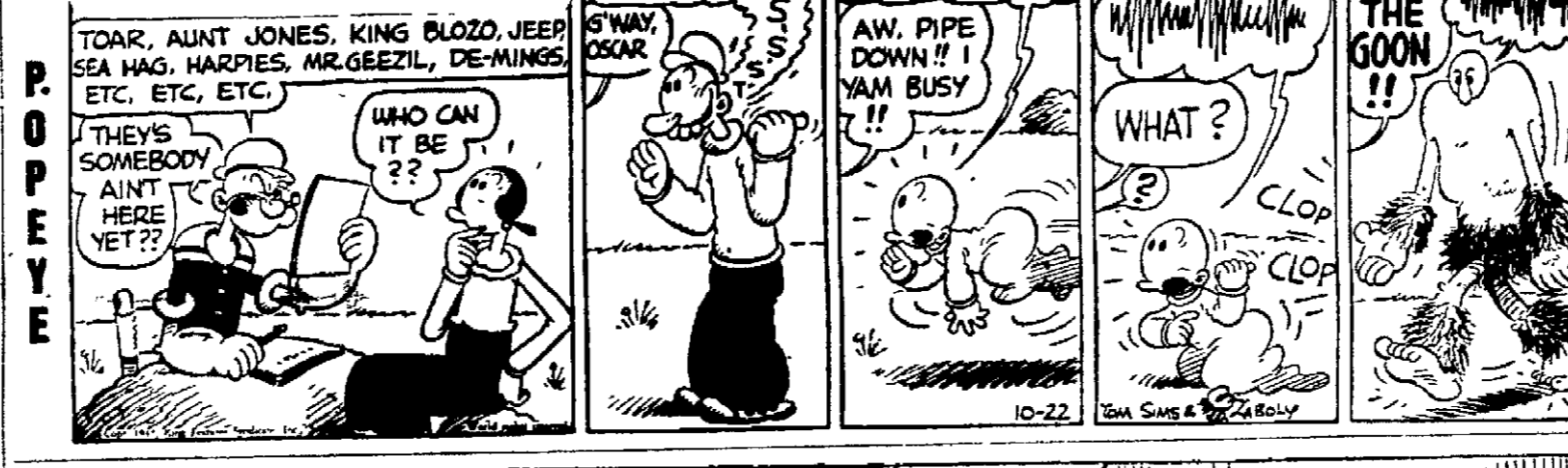
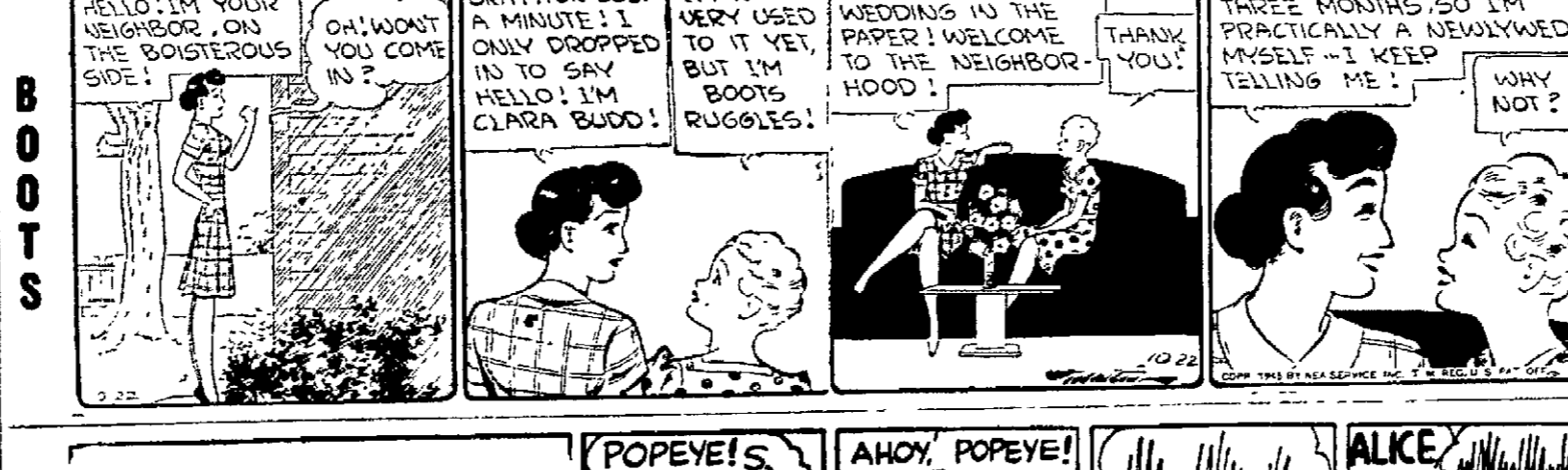

Taft Attacks Price Control

CLEVELAND, Oct. 22.—(AP)—Price control is hampering production, U. S. Senator Robert A. Taft (R-Ohio) told the City club today.

"Its advocates are trying something that no one ever thought of before when they try to increase wages without increasing prices," Taft declared. "It has destroyed any incentive for the producers."

"In theory, I would advocate some form of price control and I think the number of articles now affected by it should be reduced to a third or a fourth."

Speaking of the British situation which he termed the "key to world trade," the senior Ohio senator predicted the administration would have difficulty getting congressional approval for a proposed five billion dollar loan to Great Britain.

"It will take the British two years to get back on an even basis. They are embarrassed by a deficit in trade. They plan to use two billion dollars of the money they get from the U. S. to settle other debts with other countries, chiefly India and the Dominion," Taft declared.

Taft said he would support a loan to Britain if it could be used as a bargaining point to encourage the British to take off their present restrictions on trade.
