

Sigma Picture Rates High, Held Over Until Saturday

A picture worthy of everybody's applause is the film "Our Vines Have Tender Grapes." It has been currently killed at the Sigma theatre and is being carried over for a few more days.

The stirring, heart warming story tells of a little girl, who, tho often mischievous, is good. That is why the title. It was taken from "The Song of Solomon" in the Bible and means, when something is good, we protect it. You're certain to like the picture.

When George Gershwin began his musical career he made a hit immediately. He signed a contract to write the music for George White's Scandals and each year his music was a success. The crowning glory came, however, in 1923 when he undertook to put blue music in the show. The public couldn't grasp the meaning until Paul Whiteman and his orchestra took the "Rhapsody in Blue," that Gershwin had written upon Whiteman's request, to Aeolian Hall in New York City. The public immediately became blues conscious and his songs were hits. "Rhapsody in Blue," the film story of George Gershwin's life, is currently showing at the Ohio theatre.

The treachery of the Japanese is brought to light in the film, "The Purple Heart," now showing at the Quilna theatre. The story revolves about eight Yank fliers who bombed Tokyo, fall into the hands of the Japanese and are put on trial, not as prisoners of war, but as murderers. You'll burn with rage and thrill at their bravery.

One of the outstanding picturizations in his movie life is presented by John Garfield in "Pride of the Marines," now showing at the State theatre. Eleanor Parker, who has the role opposite him, likewise gives forth with a performance topping any and all her previous screen roles. Co-featured is "Mama Loves Papa" with Leon Errol.

Murder is bad enough, but when it is premeditated then there's no one who should not pay the penalty of death. If you don't know why, then in the film, "Three's a Crowd," opening at the Lyric theatre Wednesday, you'll learn. Sharing the billing, is "Sagebrush Heroes."

AFL Blueprints New Wage Plan

CINCINNATI, Oct. 23 — (UP) — The American Federation of Labor blueprinted its national wage policy today, a policy calling for salary increases as high as 30 per cent but with the proviso that affiliated unions may ask for less.

In announcing the policy, determined by the AFL executive council, President William Green emphasized that the council was opposed to any government policy on wages because, he contended, "such policies usually are fixed on an inflexible, arbitrary basis."

The policy set a wage ceiling based on Bureau of Labor Statistics figures which the council said represented disadvantages workers suffered in relation to commodity and service prices.
