

"It All Came True" Starts Stay At State Thursday

After a couple of years in Hollywood's cold storage, a picture has made one return appearance in Lima and is due to make another—this time at the State theatre.

"It All Came True," starring Humphrey Bogart and Ann Sheridan, will open at the State theatre Thursday. The film has been drawing huge crowds in New York and is certain to make a big hit with folks in Lima. Bogart and Sheridan turn out what is perhaps one of the most exciting and hilarious performances in their respective screen careers with Jeffrey Lynn helping out.

If you're in the mood for laughs and plenty of them, you will find "Week-end at the Waldorf" now showing at the Ohio theatre and starring Ginger Rogers, Walter Pidgeon, Van Johnson and Lana Turner. The film has two or three completely different themes but strangely enough, they tie in together. Pidgeon is out to get a rest from the weary days of being a war correspondent while Miss Rogers portrays the role of a movie star; Van Johnson lives the role of a war hero and Lana Turner, a public stenographer with Park Avenue ideas. It's all neatly formed into a glorious show.

For the mystery hounds, there's the picture "And Then There Were None" now showing at the Quilna theatre. Beginning with 10 people and slowly murdering them off until there are only two is the basis of the film with many hair raising sequences to snice the picture. Barry Fitzgerald, academy award winner, has the starring role with Walter Huston and Louis Hayward in equally important roles.

Comedy hunters—here's your show! At the Sigma theatre is "It's In The Bag" with Fred Allen and Jack Benny. Remember those two guys on the radio who are constantly feuding, well, they have stopped (at least for the present) in "It's In The Bag." Sharing the billing is "Yukon Fight."

Duncan Renaldo has the lead in "South of the Rio Grande" the picture now showing at the Lyric theatre. "Sporting Chance" with Stephen Barclay is the co-feature of this film.

Richard Dix, long-known to many as the man who usually plays the lead in the "Whistler" films, has the lead in another type picture—"Man of Conquest" with such well known supporting players as Joan Fontaine and Gail Patrick. The picture promises to live up to all of Dix's other films.
