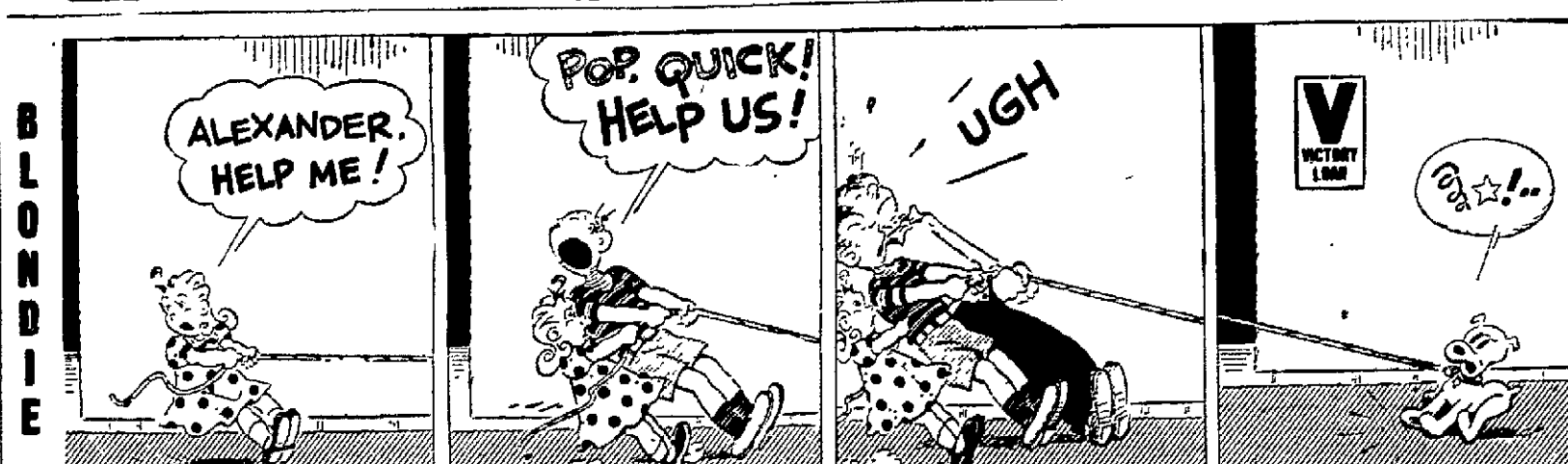
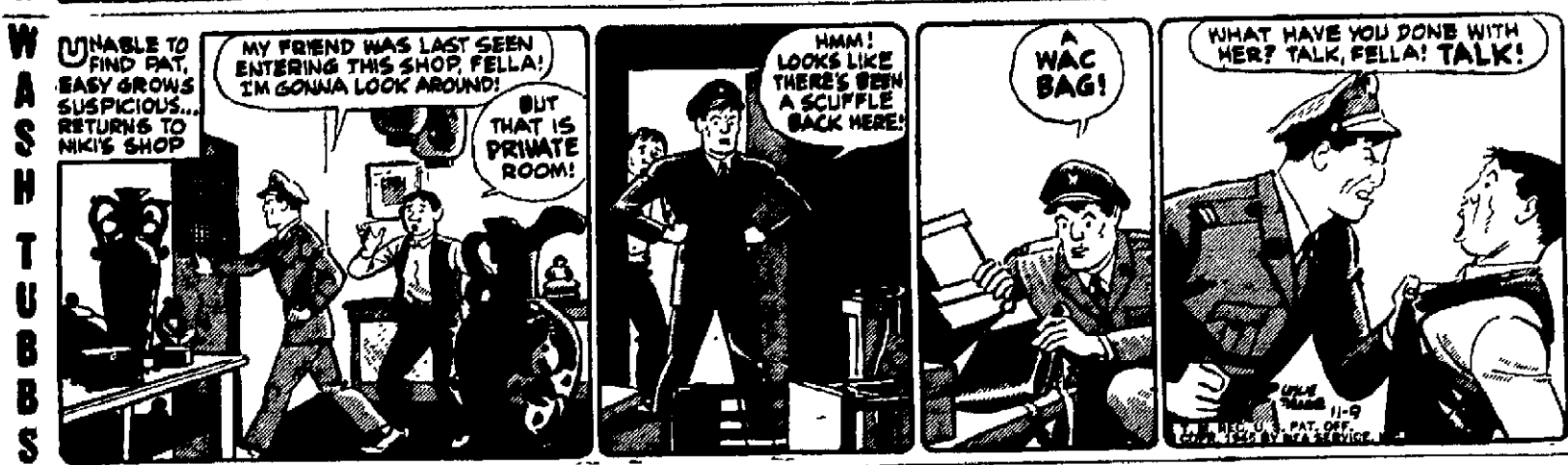
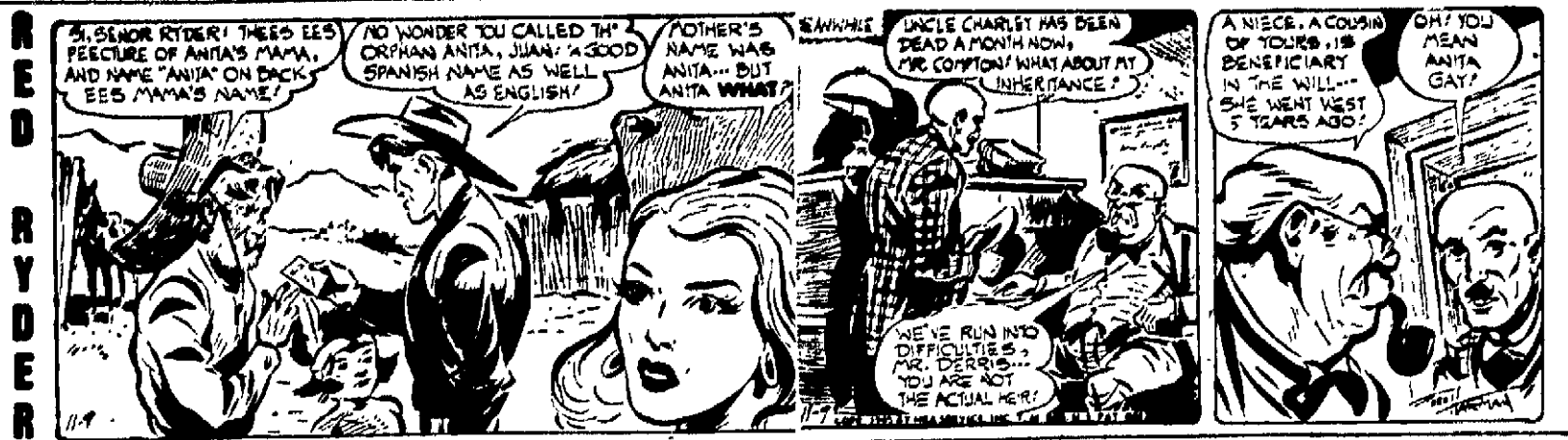

3 Issues Approved By Wapak Voters
(Lima News Bureau)
WAPAKONETA, Nov. 9.—Board of Elections officials Friday had completed count on three special issues, all of which were approved in last Tuesday's election by substantial margins.
Heading the list was the \$70,000 street building and repair bond issue, which received 1,319 votes for and 418 against. The mill levy for sewers passed 1,278 to 454, while the two-mill school levy was renewed by a 1,297 to 392 vote.
