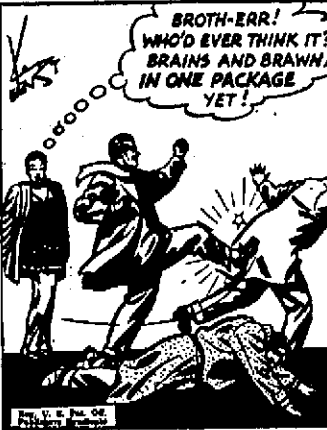

MILWAUKEE (UP)—The Harnischfeger Corp. today was mailing back pay checks totaling \$900,000 to about 2,000 incentive and office workers in compliance with an order issued in 1943 by the wages and hours division of the U. S. department of labor.
