WAGE PARLEY SCHEDULED CANTON, Nov. 28 — (AP) — Officials of the CIO-United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers of America scheduled a meeting Friday with the management of the Hoover Co., sweeper manufacturers, to discuss further union demands for a \$2 a day wage increase. Rejecting the demands yesterday, the company said the increase would add \$1,250,000 a year to the firm's annual payroll which was hiked \$1,459,000 during the war—greater than the operating profit of the company in any peacetime year.
