Relatives Ask **Details On Loss** Of Indianapolis

WASHINGTON, Nov 30 (UP)—Persistent demands for details by relatives of dead and missing crewmen were a major! factor in the Navy's decision to: hold a court martial for the skipper of the ill-fated cruiser Indianapolis, it was learned today.

Every one of the 1,196 men aboard was killed or injured when the ship went down in the Pacific last July 30. Congress as well as the Navy

was known to have received a flood of inquiries regarding the tragedy. Court martial proceed ings against the skipper, Capt. Charles B. McVay, III, were ordered to clear up the mysterious circumstances surrounding the sinking. Questions still under Navy in-

vestigation include the determination of just why the survivors were allowed to remain in the water for five days before being picked up and why an escort was material to the Army air forces at Guam. These considerations, however, will not be taken up during McVay's court martial which will concern only the loss of the ship. The proceedings begin Monday.

While the Navy has not revealed officially how the Indianapolis met its fate, some authoritative sources believe that the cruiser may have collided with a torpedo-laden Japanese sub which was surfaced at night. Others believe that the ship actually was torpedoed.




