

Daring Exploits Revealed In "First Yank In Tokyo"

An Army officer's daring exploit in reaching the heart of the Japanese capital in disguise is the basis of "First Yank Into Tokyo," the new dramatic thriller opening at the State theatre Thursday.

Because an ordnance expert with plans to perfect the atomic bomb is held by the Japs, it is imperative that an agent make contact with him. Steve Ross (Tom Neal), an Air Force pilot who speaks the language like a native, volunteers for the perilous appointment—largely because his fiancée, Abby Drake (Barbara Hale) was reported killed on Bataan and he feels the future hasn't much for him anyway.

Navy Revises Discharge Plan

WASHINGTON, Dec. 5.—(INS)—The Navy department today revised its discharge program to permit enlisted men 38 years old, with one or more dependents, to become eligible immediately for release.

A spokesman said that 35,000 enlisted personnel are affected by the action, most of whom already were eligible by reason of points.

Previously the discharge age was 42 and a man in that category needed three or more dependents to be eligible for discharge. Dependents acquired after Aug. 15, 1945, cannot be included in applications for release.
