Brodhead Cooperative Files Incorporation

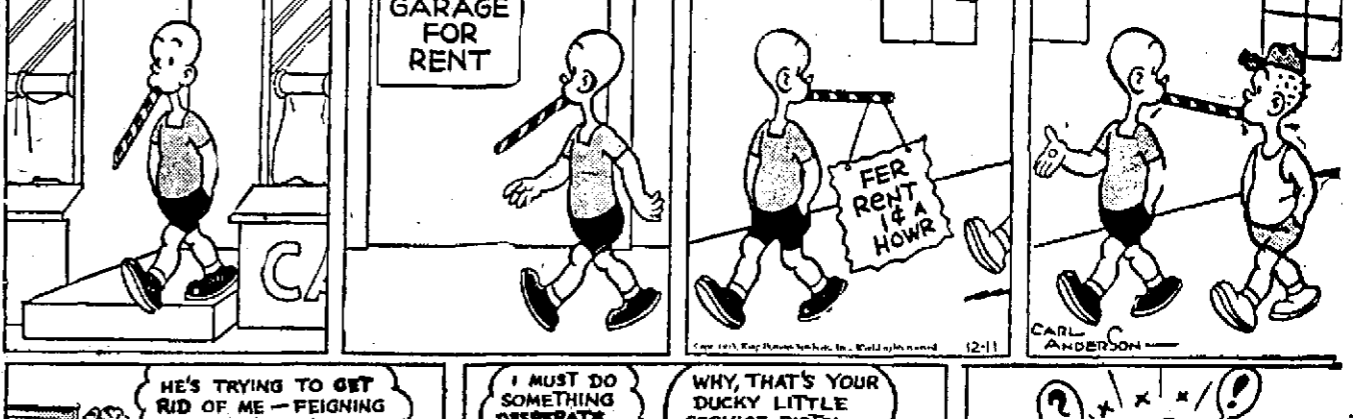
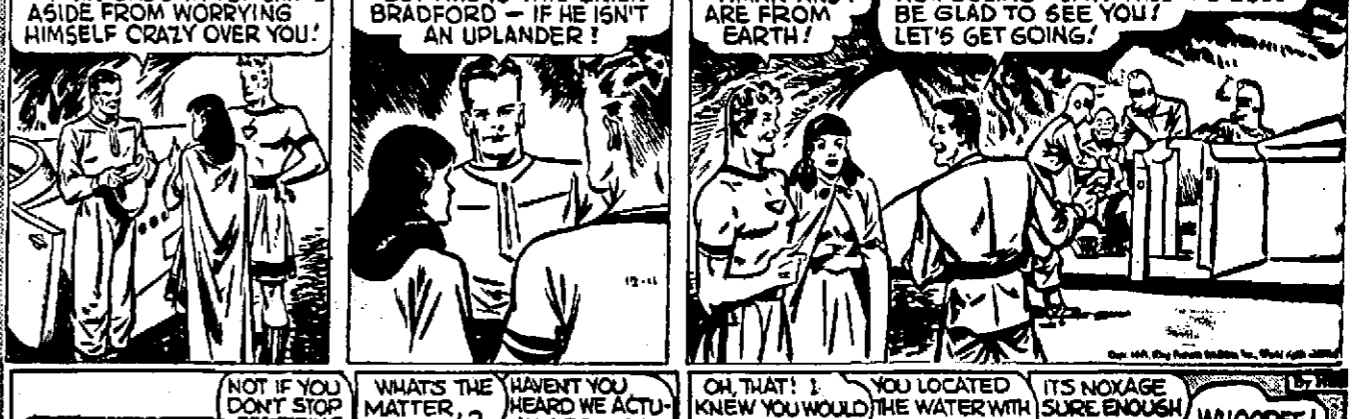
The Green Country Dairy Improvement Cooperative, Incorporated, has filed articles of incorporation at the secretary of state's office. The non-stock co-op was organized by Leo A. Scheberle, Fred Schneberger, Casper Jaggi, H. D. Paris, and Walton Campbell. The purpose is to improve the sanitary conditions under which milk is produced on farms, the founders stated.

Red Is Favorite Color in Sardinia's National Costume



MYRTLE

Caps of a queer kind are worn by Sardinian men. These are black, or blue, or black coats. They take seats at either side of the church, and in the rear.

In another section of Sardinia, it is common for men to wear white shirts and red vests. Over the vests they have coats with "slashed sleeves." The coats may be either red or black. Over a pair of linen trousers they wear a kilt, of a sort, made of dyed-colored wool. Black leggings and shoes, or boots, complete this costume.

Men in Sardinia have a special fondness for silver buttons. Rows of such buttons are sewed on their vests or coats. Often the buttons are silver coins.
