

# Raft May Be Seen In Great Role In "Nob Hill" At Lyric

LONDON, Dec. 17.—(INS)—The London Financial Times said today Hugh Dalton, chancellor of the exchequer, would introduce in commons early next year an exchange bill reinforcing the control of international capital movements.

CHARLOTTE, Mich., Dec. 17.—(AP)—Three children were killed and three others were saved by their mother Saturday when a Grand Trunk Railroad mail express ploughed into their auto which had stalled on a grade crossing four miles south of here.

State police said the six children and their mother, Mrs. Harold Root of Carmel-twp., Eaton-co., were enroute home from a Christmas shopping trip when the mishap occurred. Christmas packages were intermingled with wreckage of the auto.

The three victims were identified as Betty, 14, Sharon, 6, and Robert, 2, all of whom were riding in the rear seat of the car.

Police said the mother aided the other children—Bonnie, 13, Janice, 9, and Phillip, 4—to safety just as the train smashed into the car. The accident scene was less than a mile from the Root home.
