Noted British Admiral Dies

LONDON, Dec. 26.—(AP)—Admiral of the Fleet Lord Keyes, 73, one of Britain's outstanding naval heroes and leader of the spectacular Zebrugg raid in the First World War, died in his sleep today.

Adm. Keyes was credited with a large part of the success of combating the German submarine menace in World War One, and as commander of the Dover patrol he organized the famous St. George's Day operation which sealed up the Bruges Canal in 1918.

Retired in 1935, he returned to active service in 1940 after serving as a conservative member of parliament. A director of combined operations in 1940 and 1941, he was one of the sponsors of the commandos.

His son, Lt. Col. Geoffrey C. T. Keyes, was killed in 1941 while leading a commando raid on Field Marshal Rommel's headquarters in North Africa.
