Millhouse, in the local hospital here, is suffering from a threeknife wound that extends from the esophagus to the right side of his neck and also from shock and exposure. His condition, however, is not regarded as critical.

Millhouse, half-dazed and weakened from the loss of blood, was found in an alley within a block of his freight office by Ralph Mosier and Leroy Davis, drivers for the Dayton-Greenville Transportation Lines who heard his faint calls for help.

According to Patrolmen B. F. Blanke and Richard Breese, who investigated the case, Millhouse related the men drove up in front of his office and beckoned for him to get in the car. He said he thought he recognized one of the men but after he entered he realized he was mistaken.

Millhouse said that "somewhere" in the northeast section of the city the car was stopped and the driver whipped out a knife and slashed him across the neck as the other abductor held him. Later he was tossed out of the car at the Kennedy Mfg. Co. plant. He staggered to within several hundred feet of his office where he collapsed and was found.




