

Fans Get New Romantic Duo In Quilna's Picture Friday

Since film fans always grab a new romantic team which clicks with them and scream for more, this reviewer may as well prophesy right now that Rosalind Russell and Lee Bowman will be seen again together after their portrayals in the new comedy, "She Wouldn't Say Yes" opening at the Quilna theatre Friday.

Of course, it's nothing new for each of these stars to give a top-notch comedy performance. Miss Russell has been doing it for years and Lee Bowman came into his own in "Impatient Years" and "Tonight and Every Night."

In the film, Rosalind is a brilliant psychiatrist, who, when attempting to cure a South American dancer (Adolphe Menjou) of his habit of kissing men—she thinks her kisses kill them—discovers, thru Lee Bowman, and thru Nixie, her cartoon creation, that she herself is inhibition-ridden.

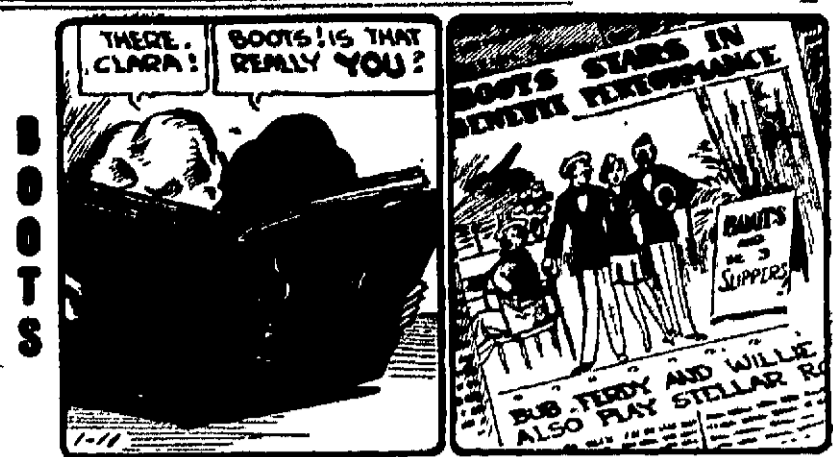
Coming to the theatre Sunday will be "In Old Monterey" with Gene Autry and "Cowboy and the Senorita" with Roy Rogers.
