ANTI-TETANUS SERUM CUTS DANGER FROM LOCKJAW

When I was a small boy, someone told me about a case of lockjaw. A certain child had fallen ill with the disease. At first he could put three fingers between his jaws, then two fingers, then only one. Finally his jaws became shut so there was not even a space between the teeth for a single finger.

It gave me a fairly good idea of lockjaw, or tetanus. This disease commonly works on the jaws until they are clenched together.

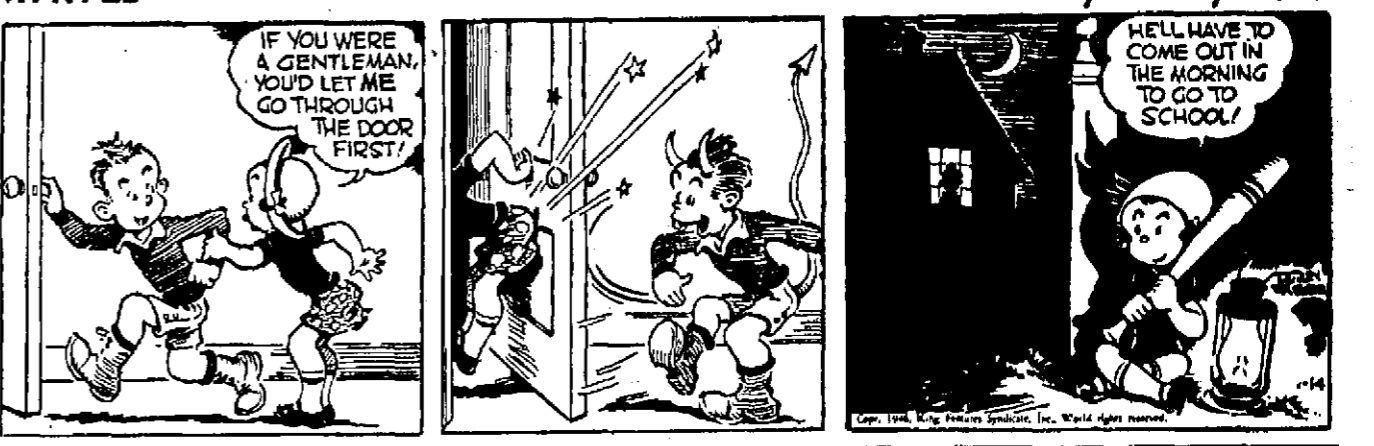
In the old days, little was known about a good way to treat lockjaw. More than half of those who suffered from it died. It has been estimated that seven out of eight of those who receive no treatment at all will die.

Lockjaw germs, or "bacilli," are rod-shaped, but they have hairlike "flagella" around them. If a person cuts his foot or finger, and gets dirt in the wound, he is in danger. The bacilli live in soil and manure, also in dust.

Deep wounds usually cause the trouble, but lockjaw has been known to arise after small scratches. If a person suffers a small scratch and treats it at once
