Tuition Fees for Vets' Wives in State Clarified

All Wisconsin women who mary non-resident soldiers do not have to pay non-resident tuitions, Atty. Gen. John E. Martin ruled today in a case involving a student at Eau Claire State Teachers college.

Martin ruled that non-resident tuition was not chargeable to a Wisconsin woman who had married a non-resident soldier "who while stationed in Wisconsin and prior to the marriage furnished who after marriage resided with his wife in Wisconsin."
