

New Suspense Thrill Offered In Film at Sigma Wednesday

Murder, mingled with Gilbert and Sullivan melodies, provides a new thrill in picturized suspense drama, "Girl on the Spot" opening at the Sigma theatre Wednesday.

Second Truce Called in China

PEIPING, Jan. 22.—(INS)—Nationalist and Chinese Communist troops were given their second "cease fire" order today by the tripartite executive commission which has been delegated to bring about a truce in North China. Troops were directed to withdraw in two-day marches from all scenes of conflict.

In addition field commanders were ordered to take up positions held on Jan. 13 as soon as fighting has ceased and warring elements have been separated.

Truce terms originally were delineated in effect at midnight on Jan. 13.

The executive commission is made up of American, Nationalist and Chinese Communist representatives.

France Studies Mandate Plan

LONDON, Jan. 22.—(UP)—Foreign Minister Georges Bidault announced today that France was willing to study plans for placing her African mandates under UNO trusteeship, but failed to make an outright offer of trusteeship.

Bidault gave the united assembly only qualified French-acceptance of proposals that nations holding old League of Nations mandates should turn them over to UNO trusteeship. Britain, New Zealand and Australia already have offered to surrender their mandates.

French mandates in Africa are French Cameroon and French Togoland, both former German colonies on the West African coast which were handed to France as Class B mandates in 1922.

France thus took a position similar to that of South Africa, which has indicated that it wishes to incorporate its South-

Plan Research In Vegetables
COLUMBUS, Jan. 22.—(UP)—Ohio State university today announced a \$100,000 program of research in the production and marketing of vegetables.

The Ohio State researchers, working in a field in which study was interrupted by the war, will seek to develop improved machinery, new weed-control measures, improved plant breeding methods and ways to control plant diseases.

Other projects are planned in the marketing field, including work on packaging and transportation of farm produce.

Professor Howard D. Brown of the university's department of horticulture said \$100,000 in contributions would be asked, the interest to be used to employ graduate students for work in this research.
