SPEAKER SCHEDULED

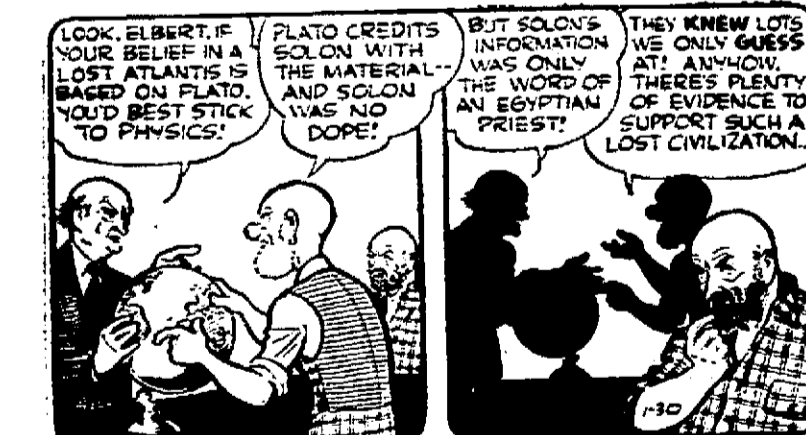

TINY BABY IS GIVEN CHANCE AT SURVIVAL
ST. PAUL, Minn., Jan. 30 — (UP)—West Side General hospital physicians said today that one-month-old Constance Mattson, who weighs only one pound 13 1/2 ounces, is out of danger and probably will live.
Doctors held little hope for tiny Constance when she was born prematurely Dec. 31, weighing two pounds, six ounces. She lost 16 ounces in six days.
The infant will require incubator care for some time, doctors said. Her father, Joseph Mattson, is a Ft. Snelling Army private.
Constance's 11-month-old sister, Cynthia, also was a premature incubator baby, weighing three pounds, four ounces at birth. Her weight dropped to below three pounds, but she now weighs 20 pounds.
