

Sigma Offers Shudderfest In Swamp Strangler Film

As "Strangler of the Swamp," the film which opens Wednesday at the Sigma theatre, a dead man returns from the grave to haunt members of the mob who lynched him and furnish chills for those who like their entertainment on the creepy side in the latest shudderfest.

The film pictures the terror which befalls a marshland community when one after another of its menfolk are found garrotted following the hanging of the village ferryman. Belief that the strangler is the ferryman's ghost becomes a reality after he is seen by several townspeople. Only when a very courageous girl offers herself as a human sacrifice is the apparition power broken and peace restored to the community.

A host of stars continues on its merry way of superb performance in "The Harvey Girls" the film now showing at the Ohio theatre. With Judy Garland turning out the vocals and Angela Lansbury, the young English girl who is going places in Hollywood, coming in for a number, the picture turns out to be one of the greatest musicals of the year. Friday will bring the long awaited "Bells of St. Mary's" to the Ohio.

Fred MacMurray in a single role can be comical enough, but he has been cast in a dual role in "Pardon My Past" the film currently showing at the Quilna theatre.
