




New Machine Will Turn Out Concrete Homes

WASHINGTON, Feb. 18-(AP) -Development of a gigantic machine which will turn out a complate, two-bedroom, low cost concrete house in 24 hours was announced today by Carl L. Estes, studied at the ramous Fre military academy at St. Cyr. Longview, Tex. newspaper pub-

Estes said the apparatus, to be manufactured in Texas soon, looks like an enormous hen laying an! egg. It maneuvers on 12-foot high pneumatic tired wheels to the desired building site. It then turns out the new home, ready for occupancy save for the installation of window panes and finishing P.M. touches. It has an 18 by 11 1-2 foot living room.

Declaring the machine will help meet a presidential request for 2.-700.000 housing units. Estes said it had been developed after years of research by R. G. Letourneau. Peoria, III., manufacturer.

The cost of the machine and of the house are expected to be announced Feb. 25 at Longview. where the machine will have its initial showing.
