

'Doll Face' To Be Feature At Quilna Theatre Friday

Starring Vivian Blaine, Dennis O'Keefe, Perry Como and Carmen Miranda and studded with a tangle of new songs is "Doll Face," the gay new musical which opens at the Quilna theatre Friday.

The film concerns itself with the saga of a "burlesque" specialty singer-dancer who sets her heart on legitimate stage stardom. As her adoring manager, Dennis O'Keefe, knows "Doll Face," played by Vivian Blaine, is beautiful and talented, but—as both discover with shock—she lacks that extra something uptown producers refer to as "culture."

When stripped of her illusions, but not of her spirit, her manager proceeds to provide her with a formidable supply of culture by hiring an ingenious literary writer to ghost-write her autobiography. This, in turn, adds more hilarity to the already humorous situation.

"Scarlet Street," the film which has been receiving such wide attention by movie critics all over the nation, has begun its engagement at the Ohio theatre starting off with a bang. Good mystery is very rare in the theatre, thus making the film something worth seeing. With Edward G. Robinson and Joan Bennett in the title roles, fans could not expect anything else except good acting. Dan Durysa holds the other role in this triangle.

Plan Opening Of New Plant

COLUMBUS, Feb. 22—(INS)—Fisher Body Co. officials said today that plant executives will arrive in Columbus soon to prepare for the opening of the company's new plant in the city.

The plant, one of three operated by the company's Ternstedt division, will be in operation by July, according to the announcement.

Erection of the plant, just west of city limits, was said to be progressing rapidly despite some slow deliveries caused by the recent steel strike.

It was estimated that 7,500 employees will be on the payroll at the plant, where interior hardware and fittings for General Motors automobiles will be manufactured.
