6th Steel Plant Signs Pay Pact

COLUMBUS, Mar. 20—(INS)—The sixth of nine Columbus steel fabricating plants closed by the "Big Steel" strike last Jan. 21 resumed operations today.

Four hundred workers at Ohio Malleable Iron Co., Columbus, ended a 57-day strike with the signing of a contract providing an 18 1/2-cent an hour increase in return for a no-strike pledge.

MANSFIELD, Mar. 20—(INS)—J. B. Montgomery of Mansfield succeeded James M. Hill as chairman of the board of the Empire Steel Corp. today. Montgomery also was reelected president of the corporation at the annual stockholders and directors meeting at Mansfield yesterday.

Others reelected included Oliver C. Henkel, vice president, secretary and treasurer, and William H. Lake, operating vice president. Montgomery reported that sales last year totaled \$9,600,000, a slight decrease from 1944. Net income was \$251,348, or \$2.13 for each share of common stock.
