

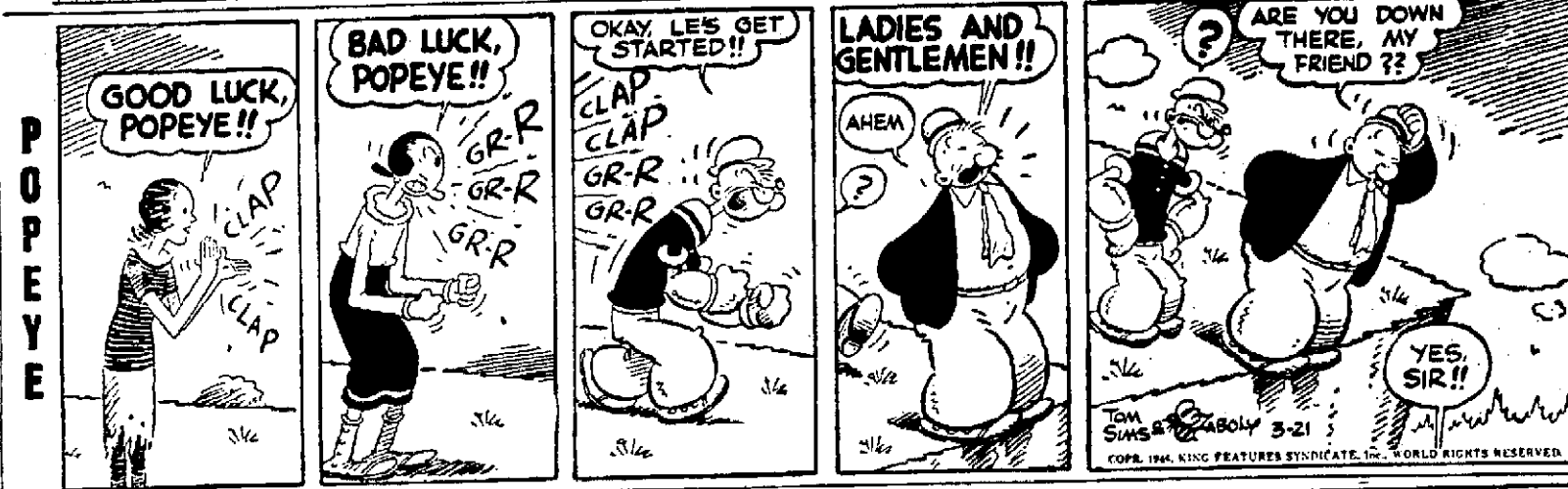
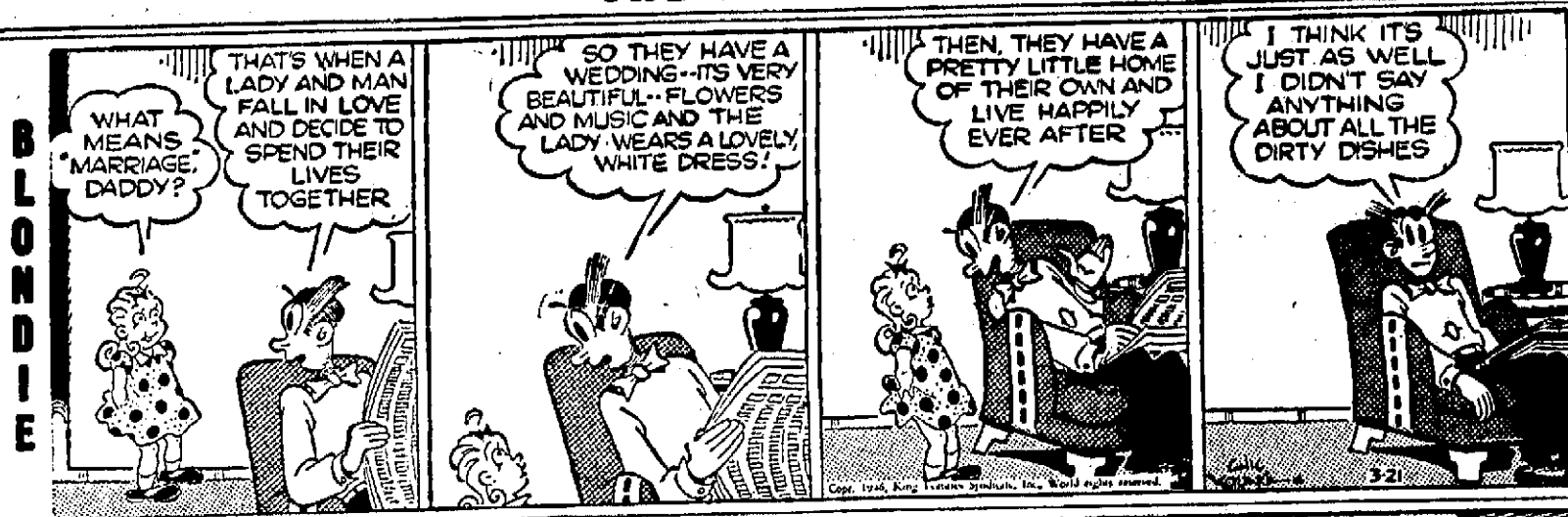
'Spiral Staircase' To Open At Ohio Theatre On Friday
