# UNRRA Awaits Soviet Answer

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., Mar. 22.—(INS)—The United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration awaited today an answer from Soviet Russia to the American claim that the U. S. S. R. should cease being a recipient of UNRRA food relief and become a contributing nation.

Nikolai Feonov, Soviet spokesman at the present UNRRA council meeting, in the first few days of UNRRA's session here, precipitated issue after issue—but he failed to answer yesterday's challenge that Russia had enough foodstuffs, not only to eliminate her from relief but to put her in the category of a contributing nation to the starving countries of the world.

United States Assistant Secretary of State William L. Clayton most pointedly called attention to the fact that Russia was selling France 400,000 tons of wheat and 100,000 tons of barley—all this to be delivered to France on American ships.

Georgiev was appointed premier and minister without portfolio on Sept. 9, 1944. His government was a coalition representing the Fatherland Front, a group of left-wing parties. It was strongly pro-Soviet.
