"Igor Gouzenko, the Russian agent who first disclosed Soviet activities to Canadian officials, turned the code over to them. Naturally, this was at once sent to

"Russia undoubtedly changed the code within 24 hours after the Soviet embassy learned Gouzenko had given it to Canada.

"But British security agents keep copies of Russian messages which they monitor, and the code was useful for them to go back and check on Russian moves for weeks previously.

"This undoubtedly gave Britain and Canada and possibly the United States valuable information on what Russia was planning."




