**PARIS, Apr. 1—(AP)—**President Felix Gouin told a Socialist National Party Congress today that the cornerstone of French foreign policy was "to avert the diversion of the world into two blocs."

To that end, he said, France wants to sign a pact with Britain on the same level of confidence and solidarity" as the French-Russian accord in 1944.
