Pilots' Strike Halted Pending Board Hearing

CHICAGO, May 11—(AP)—The threatened strike by 1,000 AFL airline pilots against Transcontinental and Western Airline (Trans World Airline), a union official said today, has been "indefinitely suspended" pending a hearing before an emergency board appointed by President Truman to study the wage dispute.

David L. Hehneke, president of the AFL Air Line Pilots' union, said in a statement the suspension was voted by the pilot master executive council after a study of the president's executive order, which was issued Tuesday before the strike was to become effective at 11:59 p. m. that day.

The pilots had voted a strike in support of maximum annual wage rates from \$13,200 to \$16,000 for pilots of four-engine planes, shorter hours and other adjustments.

769 Are Passed On State Exams

COLUMBUS, May 11—(INS)—State civil service officials disclosed today that 769 persons passed examinations held Mar. 30 to replace provisional appointees in three administrative divisions.

A total of 961 persons took the exams.

The jobs are in the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation and the Aid for the Aged and Social Administration divisions of the welfare department.

Civil Service Commission Chairman Carl W. Smith said the eligibility lists would be certified to the three divisions today.

He estimated that approximately 375 provisional employes would be replaced by June 1.

The employes to be replaced are typists, grade one, and stenographers, grades one and two.

Trio Sentenced To Long Terms

WARREN, May 11—(AP)—Sentences totalling a minimum of 56 years and a maximum of 155 years today faced three Trumbull-co jail escapees who were recaptured while attempting to rob a gasoline filling station at Railway, N. J.

Common Pleas Judge Lynn B. Griffith yesterday named these sentences for the recaptured prisoners, who pleaded guilty to prosecution charges:

Alex Losiewicz, of Youngstown, O., 20 to 75 years in Ohio penitentiary on three counts of armed robbery; Clarence Russell, 17, of Youngstown, 20 to 50 years in Mansfield, O., reformatory on a similar charge, and William Gaumer of Niles, O., six to 30 years in the reformatory on charges of burglary and larceny.

The prisoners escaped from county jail two weeks ago following an evening church service.

Mr. and Mrs. Samuel Duke, officials of the AFL-Retail Clerks International Protective Ass'n and complainants in the suits, charged in the petitions that "false, malicious and defamatory matter" was published in the magazine last Mar. 2 in an article describing a labor dispute between the union and the May Co., operator of a large department store here.
