LATIMORE, June 3—(NS)—Col. James F. Devereux, heroic commander who surrendered Wake Island to the Japanese, and Miss Rachel Clarke Cooke were married today at St. Ignatius Catholic church, Baltimore, with Chaplain Francis J. McVeigh officiating.

The couple, who left the church thru an arch of crossed swords formed by Marine officers, immediately left on a wedding trip. They will live at the Quantico Marine Base, Quantico, Va., where Col. Devereux is stationed.

Bronze Star Award Made Posthumously

NEW BREMEN, June 3—Mr. and Mrs. Ray Knipple, New Bremen, have been informed thru the adjutant general's office that the Bronze Star medal has been posthumously awarded their son, Pvt. Warren K. Knipple, who met a hero's death on battlefields of France while in the Chemical Warfare service, on July 27, 1944.

The citation accompanying the medal stated: "Working with a forward observation party, Pvt. Knipple made numerous attempts to repair severed telephone connections with rear elements of his unit, under a heavy enemy artillery barrage."

"Each time he repaired the line it was severed. He laid a new one and while acting as radio operator was struck and killed by an enemy mortar shell."
