WAGE DISPUTE SETTLED
CANTON, June 7.—(AP)—A wage dispute involving 50 AFL truck drivers and warehousemen at 32 Canton plumbing concerns, was settled yesterday by union acceptance of an undisclosed pay boost offer, Federal Conciliator W. W. Powell reported. The workers walked out May 28 to support demands for a 20-cent hourly increase to \$1.10 but returned to their jobs the following day pending negotiation of the dispute, Powell said.
