DETROIT, June 15 (AP)—Five robbers who looted a Tecumseh, Ont., bank of \$12,000 led American and Canadian police on a "cops and robbers" chase down the Detroit river last night before the authorities captured four of them on Peche Island.

Three men and a woman were in custody of Canadian police today, while officers searched the island for the other member of the gang which carried off a daylight raid on the Tecumseh branch of the Provincial Bank of Canada.
