(UP)---Closing arguments in the first degree murder trial of Arthur Peebles, 55, were delayed today until Monday after both the state and defense rested their case yetserday.

Peebles claimed during the trial that the death of Eugene Roth occurred as an accident when the 38-year-old man grabbed a gun. Roth was shot following the argument over ownership of a gasoline tank he attempted to remove from a farm owned by Peebles.

HAMILTON, June 22-(AP)-Twenty-three-year-old John F. Haywood must spend a life term in prison in the slaying last Oct. 31 of Mrs. Fannie C. Conrad, 73year-old widow.

A three-judge court found him guilty of first degree murder last night but made life imprisonment mandatory by recommending mercy.




