Await Verdict On Vet Firings

WASHINGTON, June 24—(UP)—Senate President Kenneth McKellar, D. Tenn., said today that he expected a prompt ruling from the Civil Service Commission on complaints from veterans that they are being discharged from the Oak Ridge atomic bomb plant in violation of federal laws.

McKellar conferred with Brig. Gen. K. D. Nichols, who recently investigated the Oak Ridge complaints.

McKellar said that, if the commission's decision does not settle the question, he will ask Secretary of War Robert P. Patterson for a ruling on Army policy.

The veterans maintain that they are entitled to job preference at Oak Ridge. They base their case on the veterans' preference act of 1944. It gives veterans employment preference on government and government-financed projects.

Young Praises Pullman Plan

CLEVELAND, June 24—(AP)—Chairman Robert R. Young of the Chesapeake & Ohio commented today that proposed new Pullman tariffs "will go a long way to correct the abuses in train reservations" about which the C. & O. has been conducting an advertising campaign.

Young said he had written the Pullman Co. suggesting that it continue to give consideration "to our other suggestions that block bookings of space to favored parties be discontinued and that space be reserved in the name of the individual traveler."
