DANVILLE, Ky., July 8.—(UP)—Electrical power service to 23 Western and Central Kentucky counties was disrupted partially today by a strike of members of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (AFL), employees of the Kentucky Utilities Co.

\$25,000 Reward Is Posted For Chicago Gang
CHICAGO, July 8.—(INS)—A \$25,000 reward was offered today by James M. Ragen, millionaire operator of a horse race news service, for information that will help to arrest and convict the persons who tried to assassinate him June 24.

Ragen suffered serious shoulder and arm wounds when he was hit by a shotgun blast fired from a camouflaged truck that stopped beside his automobile when it halted at a traffic light.

His condition was reported improved, but Ragen still is unable to be questioned about the assassination attempt.

Ragen charged last May 2 in a 98-page statement that members of Al Capone's old gang now are in active charge of gambling and vice in the Chicago area. The statement was given to State Atty. William Touhy.

Ragen also accused the "syndicate" of making a previous attempt on his life shortly before he issued the statement.
