

# Mystery and Murder Thrillers Open at Sigma Wednesday

There'll be mystery and murder in the air Wednesday at the Sigma theatre with the opening of two thrillers, "She-Wolf of London" and "The Devil's Mask."

Classed in the wolf murders category, "She-Wolf of London," features June Lockhart. Four murders are committed in the picture by the she-wolf, who has risen to the height of a career of murder thru superstition. "The Devil's Mask" is another eerie story, with Anita Louise and Jim Bannon.

The triangle love-story, with a touch of comedy provided by Jack Carson, is "One More Tomorrow," playing at the State theatre. With Dennis Morgan, Ann Sheridan and Alexis Smith, it's an interesting story of two girl photographers who corner a playboy—and one of them gets him. "Strange Conquest" is the other feature.

A rollicking comedy-romance (with accent on the comedy), star at the Ohio theatre. "Without Reservations" is a sensation and a scream-session. Starring Claudette Colbert as the authoress Kit Madden, John Wayne and Don DeFore as two Marines, it's action-packed, with a sequence of events leading to an original climax.

Filed from actual water scenes in the last war, "Out of the Depths" is the story of how a heroic sub-crew rescued America's high command from death. Jim Bannon and Ross Hunter are prominent in the picture at the Lyric theatre.

Burl Ives, the new singing troubadour, strums his way into the hearts of theatre-goers in "Smoky," the story of an untamed horse now at the Quilna theatre. The show has Fred MacMurray and Anne Baxter.

"Sudan" and "National Barn Dance" open Friday at the Lyric theatre. The show is open only on Friday, Saturday and Sunday each week-end.

Jeff Donnell and Fred Brady give fine performances in "Dancing in Manhattan," the story of what ensues when a truck driver finds \$5,000 in a garbage can. Also playing is "Silver Spurs." It's at the Lima Drive-In theatre.

The Gloria Drive-In theatre has "She Wouldn't Say Yes," with Rosalind Russell.




# Murder And Blackmail Highlight Mystery Drama

A weird combination of clues, all pointing to an impossible murder and blackmail scheme, involve "Nick Carter, Master Detective," in "The Case of the Black Key," at 7 p. m. Tuesday over MBS.

Nick, played by Lon Clark, investigates the death of an actress whose aversion to high places was known, and comes across a secret door in an opium den, a tapped telephone wire and a tattoo mark in the palm of a man's hand. Faced with these clues, the astute sleuth sets a trap, using himself as the bait.

Mike (The Falcon) Waring agrees to protect an alleged "stool pigeon" from a recently paroled convict who is seeking revenge. Mike's charge narrowly escapes death and turns on his protector, threatening to enlist the services of a professional bodyguard. But when the squealer's wife is mysteriously poisoned, Mike finds "Murder is No Mistake" in the latest of "The Adventures of the Falcon" at 7:30 p. m. Tuesday over MBS.

James Neighan is head in the title role of "The Falcon," and Carlo De Angelo directs the series. The regular "Radio Supper club" will be heard at 6 p. m. Tuesday over NBC with Connie Boswell as guest. Several numbers Connie will sing are "The Gypsy," "The Good Old Summer Time," and "Who Told You That Lie."

Two selections will comprise the concert of the Chicago Philharmonic orchestra, under the direction of Henry Weber. Schumann's Symphony No. 1 in B flat major, and the "Introduction" and "Wedding March" by Rimsky-Korsakoff. The program will be heard at 8:30 p. m. Tuesday over ABC.
