

Chinese Demand **UNRRA Supplies**

AWAY FOR A FEW

WASHINGTON, July 22-(AP) -The Chinese government demanded today that UNRRA resume suspended relief shipments to China and in a sharply worded statement it indirectly blamed UNRRA itself for delays in dis-

tribution of supplies. UNRRA Duector Fiorello La-Guardia announced suspension of relief shipments two weeks ago. attributing the action to jammed warehouses in the China ports. He said the jam was due to'the failure of the Chinese government to

distribute the supplies. Today the embassy said that smooth distribution a had been greatly handicapped by certain difficulties beyond China's control, such as lack of previous notice of procurement abroad, shipments without manifest or invoice.
