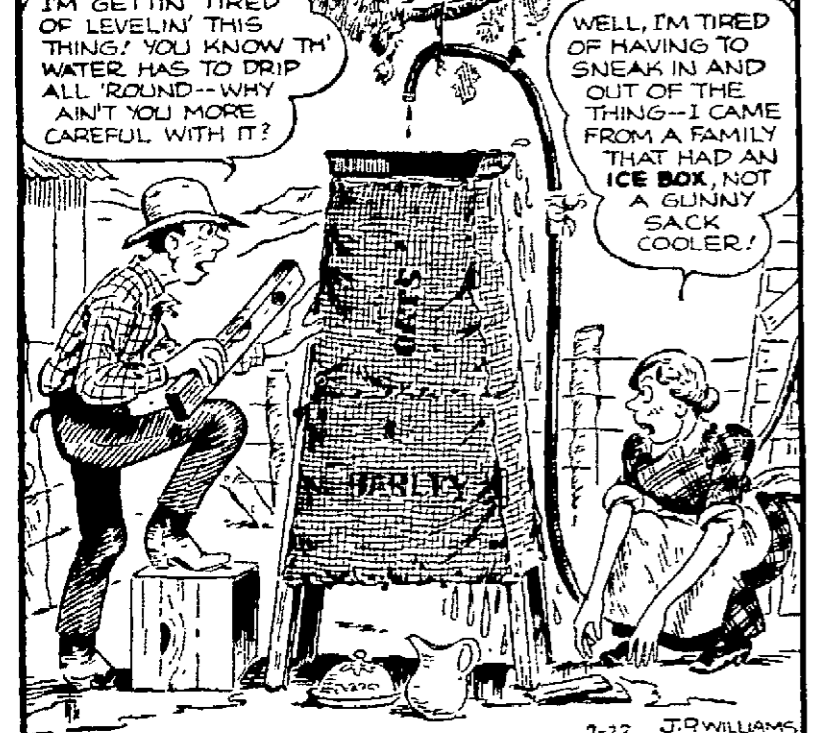

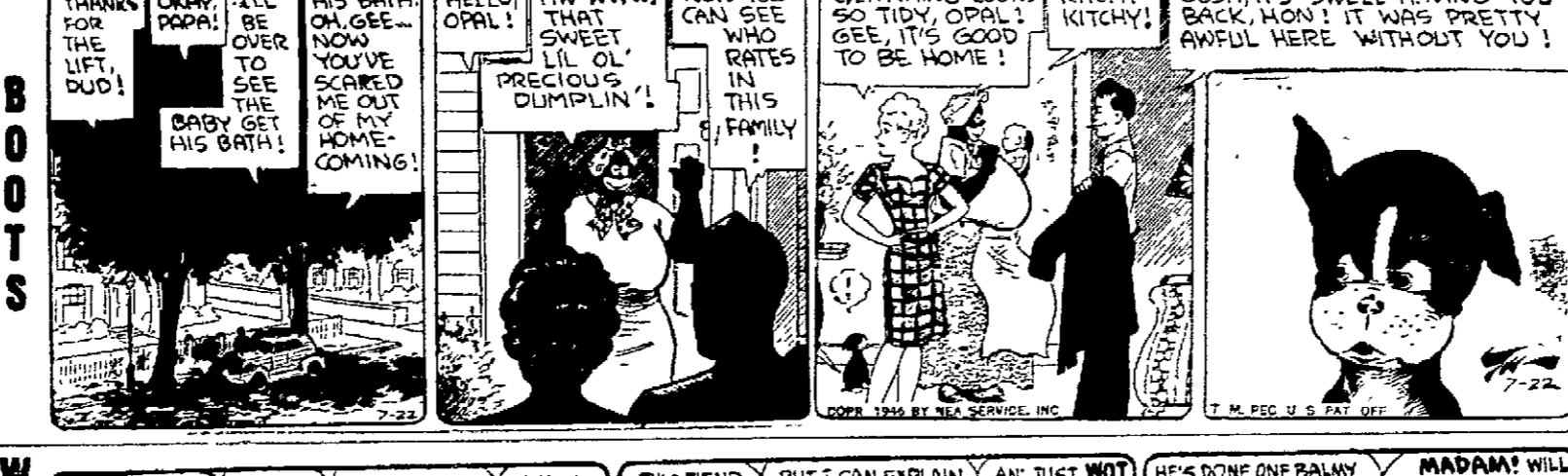
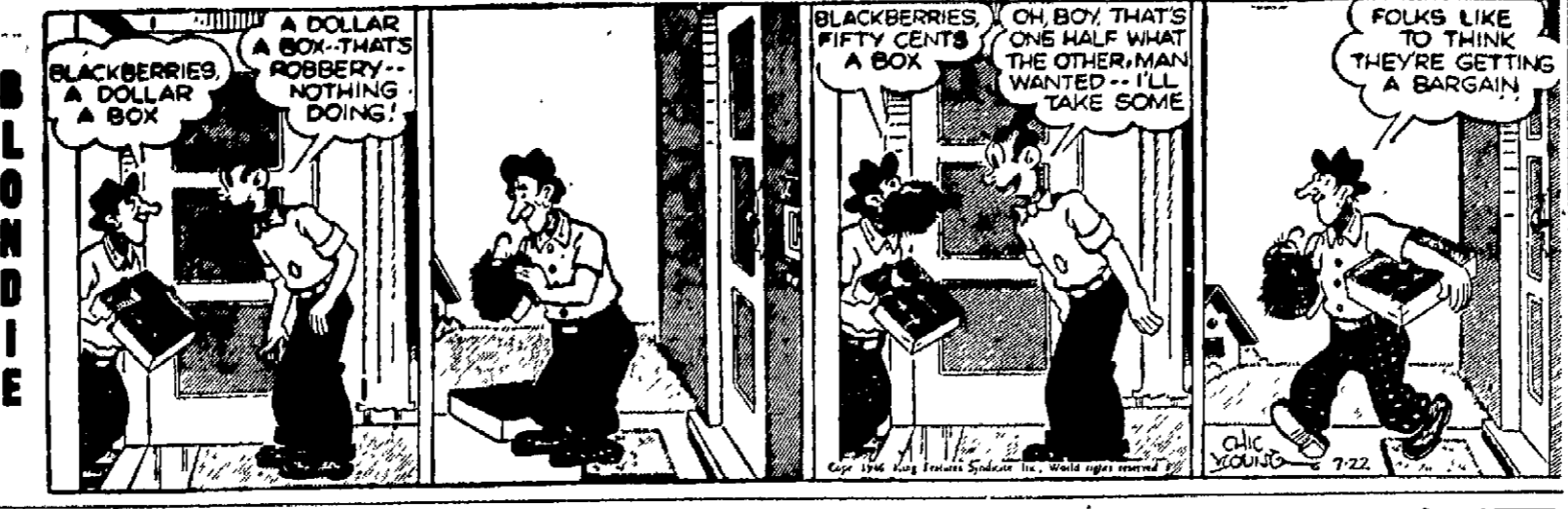

Chinese Demand UNRRA Supplies

WASHINGTON, July 22—(AP)—The Chinese government demanded today that UNRRA resume suspended relief shipments to China and in a sharply worded statement it indirectly blamed UNRRA itself for delays in distribution of supplies.

UNRRA Director Fiorello LaGuardia announced suspension of relief shipments two weeks ago, attributing the action to jammed warehouses in the China ports. He said the jam was due to the failure of the Chinese government to distribute the supplies.

Today the embassy said that smooth distribution had been "greatly handicapped by certain difficulties beyond China's control, such as lack of previous notice of procurement abroad, shipments without manifest or invoice, arrival of machinery not requested by China, or of machinery with vital parts missing."

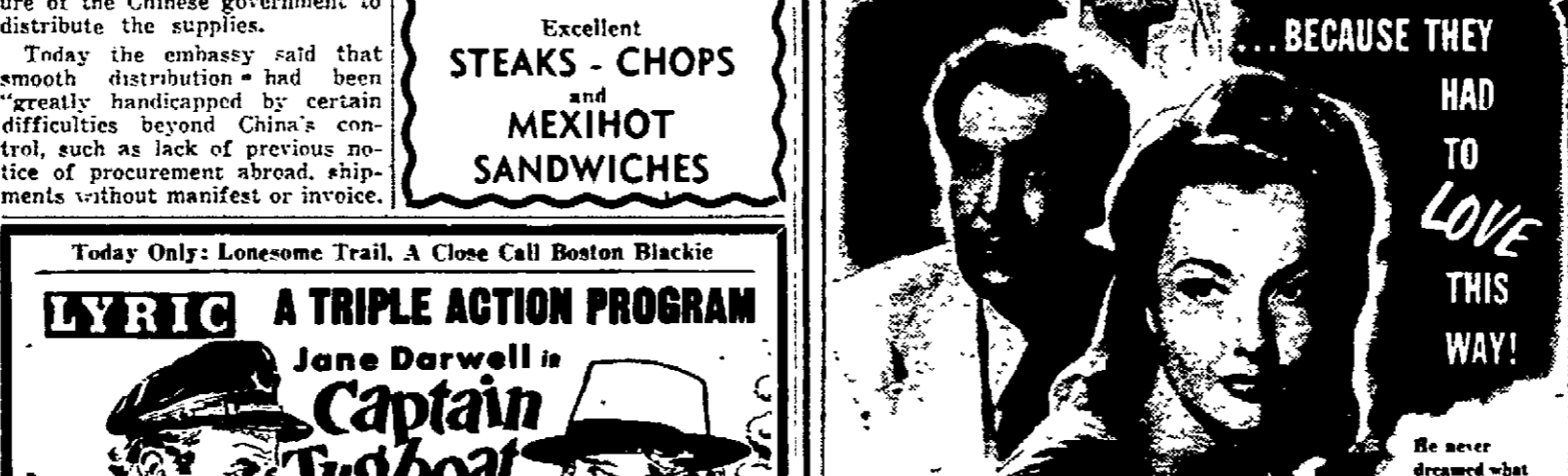
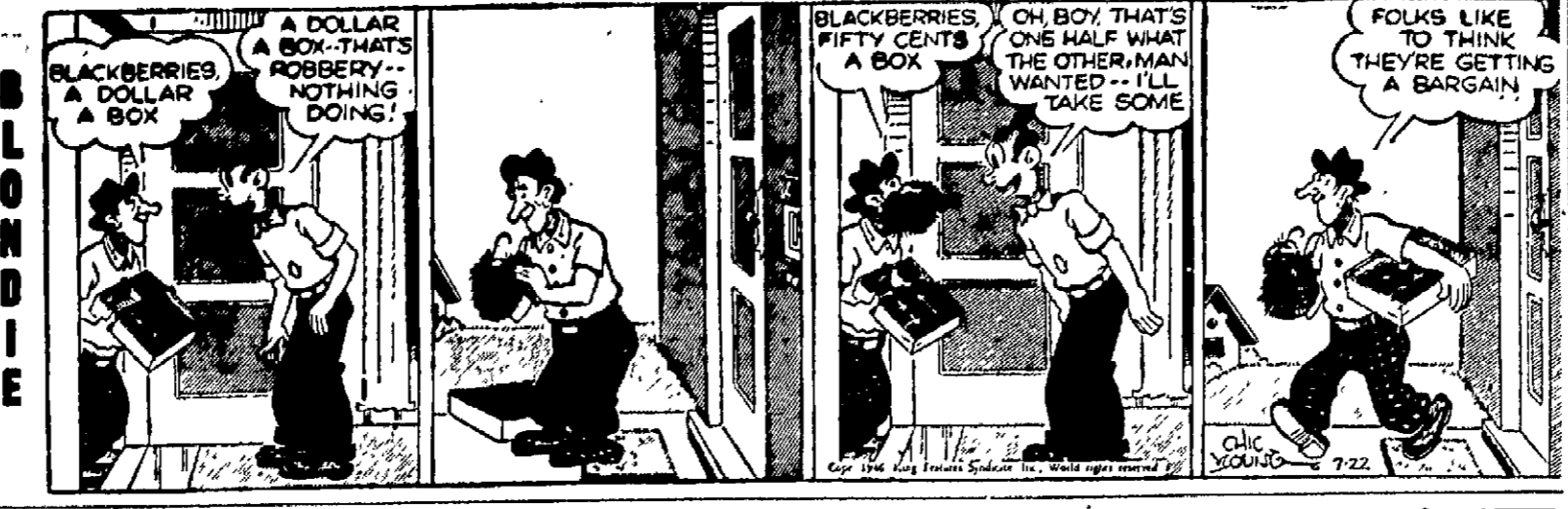
