By Alderman Lucas repeal and re-create paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 11.03 of the General Ordinances of the City of Madison entitled "Annexation of Territory and Conversion of Persons or Baggage for Hire." The Common Council of the City of Madison do ordain as follows:

11.03 (3) (a). Every person, firm, association or corporation who shall for hire or for profit, be engaged in the business of carrying passengers, with or without baggage, or who shall offer a taxicab, cab or similar transportation service to the public, shall first obtain a license from the common council and pay a license fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per year. No cab or vehicle shall be operated in such business until a permit has been issued for such vehicle and a permit fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20) per year shall be paid. The license shall be issued in the name of the owner of such cab or vehicle only and shall state the name of the licensee and the date of expiration. The license shall be issued only if the applicant is a resident of the city and is a citizen of the United States.
